In your academic years, especially when you are in your college, you are required to write research papers on different subjects. However, in some colleges, in order to complete your degree, you are required to submit a final research project.



- 6. If you have a recording, then transcribe the recording. Do not rely on notes.
- 7. You have to make sure that you present a clear examination of the demographics you have presented and keep the background and context of your participants. This is a very important factor in qualitative research.
- 8. Write down the date and the place where you conducted research and on whom. The time duration and the details of your meeting should be included in it. These are the things that you have to include in your research paper. This is why you have to keep an eye on these details.
- 9. When you write, make sure that you are following the pattern of writing a qualitative research paper.
- 10. Make a proper research question that you are going to address in your research paper.

- 11. Devise a proper hypothesis on which you will be working or the theory on the basis of which you are conducting research.
- 12. Make your analysis detailed, let your readers know what you have found, and discuss under the underlying foundation of your hypothesis or the theory you have chosen.
- 13. Conclude your research paper by including all the important points of your paper and giving suggestions and recommendations.
